



**Alberta 2019 Election Poll #2:** From April 12-14, 2019, Pollara Strategic Insights conducted an online survey among a randomly-selected, reliable sample of N=1,005 Albertans. As online surveys are not based on probability samples, a margin of error cannot be applied. A probability sample of this size would carry a margin of error of  $\pm 3.1\%$ , 19 times out of 20. The dataset is statistically weighted according to the gender and regional proportions of the population as well as an estimate of the age proportions of the electorate, based on the turnout of Albertans across age brackets in previous elections.
