

This data was collected between April 15 - 19, amongst adult Canadians who are eligible likely voters in the 2025 federal election. A total of N=2,195 respondents were surveyed, using a multi-mode methodology incorporating online panel, live-interviewer telephone (CATI), and automated telephone (IVR). A probability sample of this size carries a margin of error of  $\pm 2.1\%$ , 19 times out of 20. Our data is weighted by gender, age, and education according to the most current Census figures. In addition, we have weighted age by historical voter turnout rates so that the sample reflects the likely voting electorate.
